Stuart Chaseman is a Chicago-based singer-songwriter whose distinctive sound takes reference from such American roots rock artists such as Bob Dylan and Bruce Springsteen. A long-time artist in the Chicago rock community, his previous release was the full album Next Stop Brigadoon released in 2009.

Stuart holds regular live stream shows on Sundays called "Stuart's Super Sunday Sepia Tone" show on Facebook for his fans and supporters, and appears on the new Netflix dating reality show, "Jewish Matchmaking" which airs May 3rd. Chaseman shrugs when he connects the irony that the forthcoming single and album are inspired by his failed relationships, and he's now on a dating reality show.

Stuart Chaseman releases his first single "Sins" on April 14th and the forthcoming album "Secrets, Lies, and Alibis" will be released in May of 2023. "Sins", written in the roots rock genre, is about the false belief that happiness can be found in another person – a past relationship. The narrator eventually realizes that the bridge has been burned and that that is the consequence of his actions. The first line of the song pays homage to Bob Dylan's Like a Rolling Stone, an artist that has had a huge impact on Chaseman's songwriting style.
